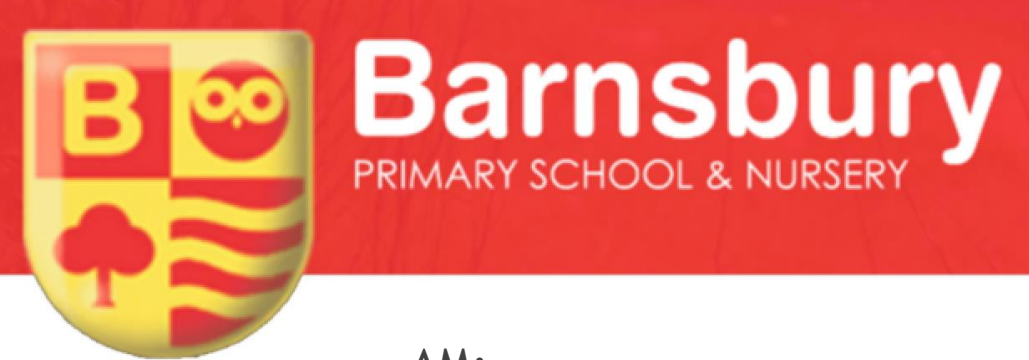

Phonics



Read, Write Inc is a daily phonics session where we practise the letter sounds and read from a book targeted at your child's current phonics level. These will be separate books from the ones sent home.

We use rhymes to teach the letter sounds. These are in your child's reading diary.



Reading



- **Read daily**
- Record reading in their *Reading Diary*
- Please praise effort and having a try at sounding out unfamiliar words
- Red words are words that can't be sounded out phonetically. These need to be learned by sight reading. A copy of these are in the back of your child's diary.
- Please support your child in understanding what they have read by asking questions about the story. This will need to be secure before they move up reading levels.

Reading Diaries will only be checked on a Friday.

Homework

Homework will be sent out half termly. This based on either Science, History or Geography. Homework is set to be creative. We want it to be a fun shared learning experience.

This is optional, but it is always lovely for us to see what the children have created at home.

Travel to school and parking

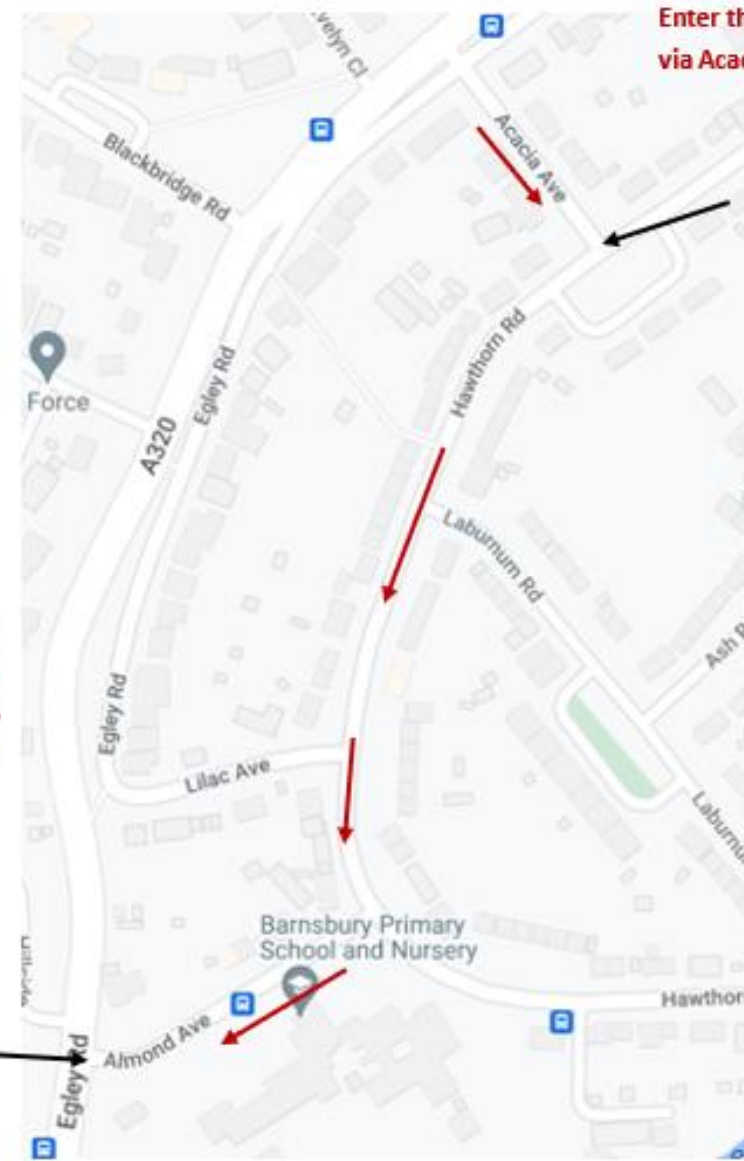


Keep everyone safe—drive slowly around the estate.
