English

- Use capital letters and punctuation accurately.
- Use time connectives to sequence events.
- Identify the features of instructional texts

Maths

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number.
- Recognise, compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = sign.

Science

Healthy Animals & Materials Matter

- Explore the useful properties of materials.
- Understand that exercise makes the heart work harder and is an essential part of a healthy lifestyle.

<u>Art</u>

- Explore composition by arranging the things collected.
- Combine different drawing media in observational drawings.

<u>DT</u>

- To design and plan a stable structure.
- To follow a design plan and make a product.

<u>RE</u>

- To learn the names, clothing, places of worship, holy books and duties of local religious leaders.
- To investigate how Christmas is celebrated by Christians around the world.

Geography

- Name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans in the context of Africa (Kenya).
- Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

Computing

- Recognise common types of technology
- Demonstrate how IT devices work together.

French

Respond to words and phrases in familiar stories.

History

- Use a wide vocabulary of everyday historical terms including those related to the passing of time e.g. before, after, a long time ago.
- Compare aspects of life in different periods.

Music

- Use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

- Use a wide range of balances.
- Perform sequences of their own composition with coordination.
